Report Required: Report of Arrival in the U.S. (Report Control
Symbol EXEMPT), par. 4b(2) (b)

1. Purpose. To delegate authority to certain field commands for issuance and/or modification of PCS orders and to prescribe instructions which will enable this Headquarters to properly administer the PCS budget.

2. Cancellation. MCO 7130.1H.

3. Information

a. The CMC (MMIA) is required to account for and allocate moves for all PCS travel. Orders issued by authorized commands other than HQMC must always reference the authority for the issuance of the orders per paragraphs 20201 and 30101 of reference (a).

b. This Order is not applicable to the transfer of Marines by service records for hospitalization. (Last sentence deleted by CH 1.)

c. Paragraph 40302 of reference (a) and paragraph 4119 of reference (b) apply to dislocation allowance entitlement which results from a second or subsequent PCS move during a fiscal year. Requests for a second dislocation allowance in the same fiscal year will be forwarded to the CMC (MMIA).

4. Action

a. Field commands depicted in enclosure (1) will submit to the CMC (MMEA or MMOA, as applicable) copies of all PCS orders

issued and/or modified.

b. Emergency Leave from Overseas

(1) Field commands, depicted in enclosure (1) and marked with an asterisk (*), are authorized to modify the effective date of PCS orders issued by this Headquarters to the date of departure on emergency leave. This modification is authorized for Marines who have less than 90 days remaining on their current overseas tours, when emergency leave is granted in the United States.

(2) Marines who have 90 days or less remaining on their current overseas tours, who are not in receipt of PCS orders, may be transferred as above, subject to the following requirements:

(a) Individuals will be directed to report to the nearest Marine Corps activity upon arrival in the United States for endorsement of their orders prior to proceeding to their emergency leave address.

(b) Individuals will be directed to report arrival in the United States by collect telegram or message, to the CMC (MMA or MMEA, as applicable), providing the following information:

- 1 Name.
- 2 Grade/MOS.
- 3 Social Security Number.
- 4 Date and time of arrival in the United States.
- 5 Port of entry.
- 6 Number of days leave authorized.
- 7 Leave address.

(c) Individuals will be informed that PCS orders will be issued by the CMC and forwarded to the leave address. If orders have not been received within 12 days of arrival at the leave address, the individual concerned will notify the CMC (MMA or MMEA, as applicable) by the most expeditious means available.

(3) Field commands who modify the effective date of PCS orders in connection with emergency leave will notify the

CMC (MM) by message.

5. Fiscal Instructions. Applicable fiscal appropriation data is found in MCO 7301.104, Accounting Under the Appropriation "Military Personnel, Marine Corps" and "Reserve Personnel, Marine Corps."
