MCFMIS Update

The East Coast has been completely implemented as of 30 May 2007. Bridgeport is currently undergoing migration and should be completed NLT 12 Jun 2007. Okinawa has also been successfully migrated. They have been updated with the new Cook Chill module which should greatly improve their overall operational capability. The remaining OCONUS sites are projected for completion NLT 30 June 2007. Food Teams will be contacting the remaining OCONUS FSO's for local MCFMIS related information. The timely exchange of this information is critical to completing the remaining sites.

We would like to thank all the FSO and Sodexo personnel for their support in this migration. Without your support and coordination, this migration would not have been possible.

RGFSC Update

- Quality Assurance Surveillance Plan (QASP). Testing of the new QASP at Camp Pendleton will commence on 1 June 2007. Prior to CONUS-wide implementation, Government and Contractor representatives will conduct a review to incorporate lessons learned from the tests. CONUS-wide implementation is now planned for fall 2007.

- CONUS-wide Master Menu. Implementation of the new Master Menu is ongoing, coinciding with the MCFMIS upgrade. This menu contains new concepts such as demonstration cooking, and is designed to address the preferences and needs of today's young Marines and Sailors. Initial customer feedback of the new menu has been very positive. An initiative to standardize fast food paper products is nearing completion, and an initiative to standardize the box lunch menus between the regions is in the planning phase.

- Upcoming RCO/RCOR/HQMC Working Group. The next working group is tentatively scheduled for September 2007 at Camp Pendleton. Please forward any requested agenda topics to the RCORs via your FSO/ACOR no later than 15 August 2007.

- Follow-on CONUS Food Service Acquisition. The acquisition team's mission is to develop an acquisition plan and strategy, define performance needs, develop a performance work statement, identify commercial market business practices, potential service providers, obtain industry feedback on working documents, develop a Government Cost Estimate and determine the best methodology to assess contractor performance; all required components of the solicitation for the follow-on contracting effort. The team is currently scheduled to brief the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Acquisition (DASN-ACQ) on 15 June 2007. This briefing will address the history and background of the current RGFSC and objectives for the follow-on acquisition, in preparation for a formal presentation of the acquisition plan to the Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Research, Development and Acquisition (ASN-RD&A) in early-2008.
